In December, my son gave me an Apple TV as a present. I am so impressed with it, that I thought I would tell you about it. As you can see, it is a small box that fits in your hand. Apple sells it for \$99 which also includes a remote control. It connects to your HDTV and optionally your receiver and enables you to stream a variety of audio and video content from sources such as your personal iTunes library (e.g., photos and music), Youtube, Netflix, your iPad, your iPhone, or your iPod Touch. You can also rent movies or television shows that are available in the iTunes store.

For Apple TV to be viable for you, you have to have a TV with a HDMI-in connection and a good Internet connection, available either via running a cable to your router or via wireless in your home.
