I recently purchased an iPhone 4 and it has become an indispensable part of my life. It truly is an amazing device!

I thought I would share with you my favorite free downloadable iPhone 4 apps:



Flashlight - You wouldn't believe how often I have used this app. It is a flashlight, but unlike other similar apps, this one uses the camera flash as the flashlight.



MapQuest - If you are traveling somewhere and don't already have a navigation system, this app is awesome, because it provides voice directions as well as all the other typical functions.



RedLaser - This app uses the iPhone's camera to read a bar code, look up the item in the Internet, and display locations where it can be purchased and the associated price. It takes comparative shopping to a whole new level!



AroundMe - AroundMe solves the problem of finding the nearest gas station, Starbucks, grocery store, movie theatre, restaurant or bar (as well as many other places) quickly and easily, and then shows you how to get there!



Fly Delta - Most of the major airlines (such as the one shown here from Delta Airlines) as well as Expedia and similar sites, now provide iPhone apps that let you check on flight status, flight schedules, and display your reservations.



Movies by Flixter - This great app, integrated with Rotten Tomatoes (a website that gathers and integrates reviews from the public as well as from critics), provides everything you need to know about movies, nearby theaters, show times, etc.



Words with Friends - If you like the game of Scrabble, you will love this app. It allows you to play Scrabble with friends or anonymously, with the ability of playing a large number of games simultaneously. Very addictive!



Pandora - If you never heard of Pandora, you are really missing out. Pandora lets you enter your favorite musical artist or group and it then creates a radio station out of that artists's music combined with similar genres.
